Juan Carlos López - Conservatory of Tolima (Tolima)

Juan Carlos López, a pianist from Ibagué, is recognized for his talent and academic background. He studied at the Conservatoire of Tolima and at the National University of Colombia, where he received his M.A. in Music Education. He is a concert pianist, soloist, accompanist, and pedagogue, and is currently working at the Conservatory of Tolima. He promotes classical music through the "Toca 88" project.

She is known for her passion, expressiveness, and extensive experience. She is the founder of the Piano Festival of the Americas and the Pianissimo Foundation.
